LBJ Band Audition Music and Information

Welcome to the LBJ Band program! We are excited to have you join our award winning band program, one of the finest in the state. All incoming Freshmen will qualify for the marching band. To best place you in our band classes here at LBJ, we ask everyone to do a live audition for an LBJ director. Auditions will be heard beginning in mid- February to May. Directors will come to your campus for the audition.

Audition Information:

(1) Play three (3) of your favorite scales. Play them 2 octaves when possible, however 2 octaves are not required. The chromatic scale may count as one of your three scales.

(2) Play the two excerpts (tunes) shown below.

(3) Optional: You may play an advanced solo excerpt (5 to 8 lines) of a difficult piece from your concert band folder or a solo that you have worked up. The purpose is to show us your "advanced playing skills". Performing step 3 will enhance your score which could result in an overall audition that places you in one of the two advanced LBJ bands (Symphonic and Wind Ensemble).

(4) Sight reading. Everyone will be asked to sight read a simple two-line tune.
