

ATTENTION LBJ BAND STUDENTS WHO WANT TO EARN MONEY FOR BAND TRIP OR OTHER BAND COSTS!!!

LBJ Band students are invited to participate in two student fundraisers to earn money for their band student ledger accounts. The following fundraisers will take place in late summer and fall 2008: (1) selling Macy's "Shop for a Cause" coupons, and (2) selling Simon "Evening of Giving" coupons.

MACY'S SHOP FOR A CAUSE

Participating band students will sell each Macy's coupon for \$5.00; all \$5.00 will get credited to the student's ledger. The coupon purchaser receives \$10.00 off on a single purchase of \$20.00 or more (with some items excluded), 10% and 20% off certain categories of store items all day on the day of the event, and a chance to win a \$500.00 Macy's shopping spree. Coupon purchasers may ONLY use the coupons on the official "Shop for a Cause" date: Saturday, September 20, 2008.

The non-profit group that has the most coupons redeemed at the Macy's at Highland Mall will receive a large sum of cash. Last year, LBJ won this prize and received an extra check for \$1,500 during the fall event. So help your student and help your band -- sell "Shop for a Cause" coupons at the first opportunity. The coupons will be distributed in envelopes with 5 coupons each and each coupon MUST be either sold -- and the money turned in to the vault in the band hall -- or turned back in to the band vault unsold. Coupons may be sold to family, friends, church members, etc. at any time chosen by the band student (outside of school). We are also hopeful that the Macy's coupons will again be sold from a booth at Highland Mall on certain dates yet to be assigned. Coupons are not yet available for sale; DeDe Hebner (info below) will make an announcement via email to the band family when the coupons are available.

SIMON EVENING OF GIVING

Participating students will sell Simon Evening of Giving tickets for \$10.00 each; for each ticket sold, \$7.00 will be credited to the student's ledger. Simon Evening of Giving will occur at Barton Creek Mall on Sunday, November 23, 2008. For the event, Barton Creek Mall is closed to the public; only ticket-holders are allowed into the mall. Many stores will have exclusive sales to ticket-holders, and there is food, entertainment, a fashion show, and Santa for the little ones. Great for holiday shopping, and for credit in the student's band ledger as well! Like Macy's coupons, the Simon Evening of Giving coupons will be distributed in envelopes with 5 coupons each and each coupon MUST be either sold -- and the money turned in to the vault in the band hall -- or turned back in to the band vault unsold. Coupons are not yet available for sale; DeDe Hebner (info below) will make an announcement via email to the band family when the coupons are available.
