This release does not apply to claims of intentional misconduct or gross negligence.

In case of emergency, I hereby give permission to the licensed physician and/or hospital, selected by an LBJ Director or band parent volunteer, to perform or provide X-ray examination, anesthesia, and/or medical and surgical diagnostic procedures and treatments considered necessary in the best judgment of the attending physician for Participant.
